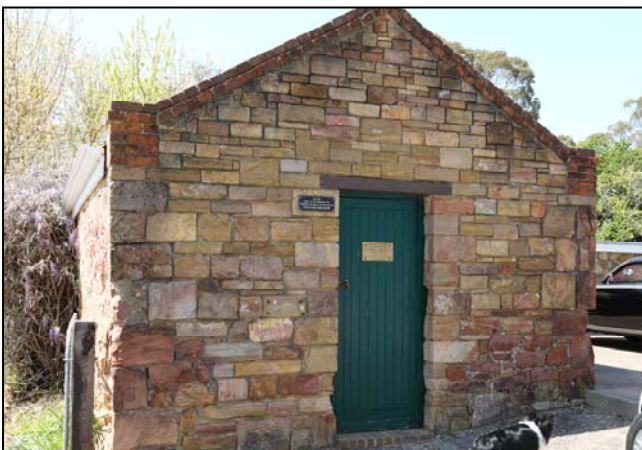

In 1900 TJ Richard moved to premises in Hindmarsh Square.



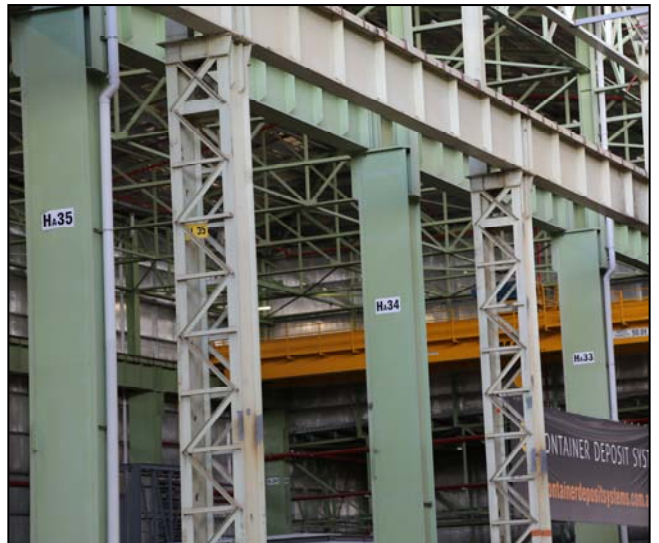
The demolition of the Keswick factory was completed a month before this event, so the following is a photo that was “prepared earlier”.
