

ADDITIONAL TOUR INFORMATION

Good folk of the Chrysler Restorers, yes, it's me again, the noisy Croweater!

From the first week in October you have been here <http://www.chrysler-restorers-sa.org.au/> and clicked on the button marked **2019 Tour** on the left hand side and downloaded your Registration papers for the National Tour. Now I suppose you want to know how much all this is going cost. A fair question indeed!

You will see that the registration costs have been kept low and that will include all the usual items. The daily runs are entirely free of charge of course apart from your vehicle costs and any sundries you choose to purchase along the way.

Let's start with meal costs.....Registration Day, Monday, September 30th is of course **MoPar Monday** with the meet-n-greet evening meal being a Detroit style all American BBQ that is entirely subsidised. Free, gratis, not a cracker of cost in other words.

Tuesday, a community village luncheon which, including entrance to three museums, will set you back \$20.00 per adult. It's **Rootes Group Tuesday** (do you see a pattern emerging?) so an English buffet evening meal is provided at \$25.00 per adult. Guest speaker entirely free.

Workers Wednesday at a special location gives you the option of a pub lunch at a subsidised \$24.00 per adult or a café option at around \$15.00 per adult. The evening meal is your choice and we hope you will look for value in McLaren Vale itself where special deals/vouchers await you.

True Blue Thursday and we are going coastal so a running-board lunch provided by a community group will be available for collection at \$12.00 per head to be followed by an all Aussie evening meal at \$25.00 per adult. You get to dance for free to live entertainment if it pleases you.

FCA Friday, the Fiat connection and what else? It's an Italian style evening meal at \$25.00 per adult. Lunch will be at your own devices as there are a number of options available. More on that later.

Shannons Simca Saturday is our Display and judging day with community/charity BBQ stalls for lunch and a French inspired three course evening meal at a subsidised \$50.00 per Adult. We'd like you to think about "frocking-up" for this evening event or maybe dressing in clothing appropriate to the era of your vehicle. If not, the event shirts will be fine so long as you wear pants or a skirt as well !

Thus, if you join us for every meal on offer, and we hope you will, your outlay will be \$181.00 over and above your entry and accommodation costs. By the time you allow for the odd sandwich, BBQ sausage and Wednesday evening at your own devices you will need to allow maybe \$225.00 - \$250.00 each for your meals. Wonderful value given the quality on offer! Don't forget, this is gourmet tucker.

But what of breakfast I hear you cry? Well that is going to depend entirely on the accommodation you choose. If you wish to stay at Serafino McLaren Vale Resort then a cooked breakfast for two is included in the \$195.00 per night special room rate. **For bookings at Serafino you should call them direct on (08) 8323 8911** and tell them you are Chrysler folk.

For all other accommodation and breakfast combinations you need to contact the **McLaren Vale and Fleurieu Visitor Information Centre** (Cathy Kerrison) on **(08) 8323 9944** or email catker@onkaparinga.sa.gov.au and let them know what you require and that you are part of the Chrysler Restorers Club 15th National Tour. **They will make your booking for you if you would like.**

So your accommodation and breakfast might cost a further \$1,170.00 per couple or somewhere a long way short of that figure depending on your taste and budget and eventual accommodation location and if you are happy to carry a toaster under your arm.

Now to the matter of entry and excursion fees. We've already discussed the museum entry fees for Tuesday so let's talk about Wednesday. We have a run planned to that special location where the group will split in two. There will be free admission and things to see and do or the AM group will be offered a bus tour with commentary from an internationally renowned author at a cost of \$25.00 per head including an informative booklet supplied by our author/guide. In the PM, following our pub or cafe lunch the groups will be reversed with the PM group taking the bus tour and the AM group engaging in the free wanderings. There are limited seats on the coaches so early bookings are advised.

Thursday, you don't have to allow for any entry fees just enjoy the views and your cars.

Friday is a matter of choice. There are museums to choose from and/or a choice of boat excursions. You might choose to travel by launch to the Murray Mouth at \$42.00 per person or by paddle steamer on Lake Alexandrina for two hours at \$26.00 per head including morning/afternoon tea or maybe you want to do it all? So Friday might cost you another \$100.00 each or maybe just \$20.00 and some shoe leather walking around historic towns. The choices are yours and you have until March to decide although boats have maximum seats unless you want to be lashed to the mast so if you are really keen then get in early.

Now the trivia night will be amazing! Won't cost you a cracker and you have the chance to win something....err....trivial!

Shirts? Yes, yes, yes, two colours to choose from in male and female cuts. \$45.00 each and we are sure you'll want both or a different colour each so best allow for \$90.00.

Saturday we've already discussed so now you know what you need to know and what you need to do.... **REGISTER EARLY and BOOK YOUR ACCOMMODATION THROUGH EITHER THE MCLAREN VALE AND FLEURIEU VISITOR INFORMATION CENTRE OR SERAFINO MCLAREN VALE RESORT.**

All other paperwork will be sent out in the first week of April 2019. If further sponsorship is obtained then meal costs will be further reduced but you have until April as above to think about all that.
